

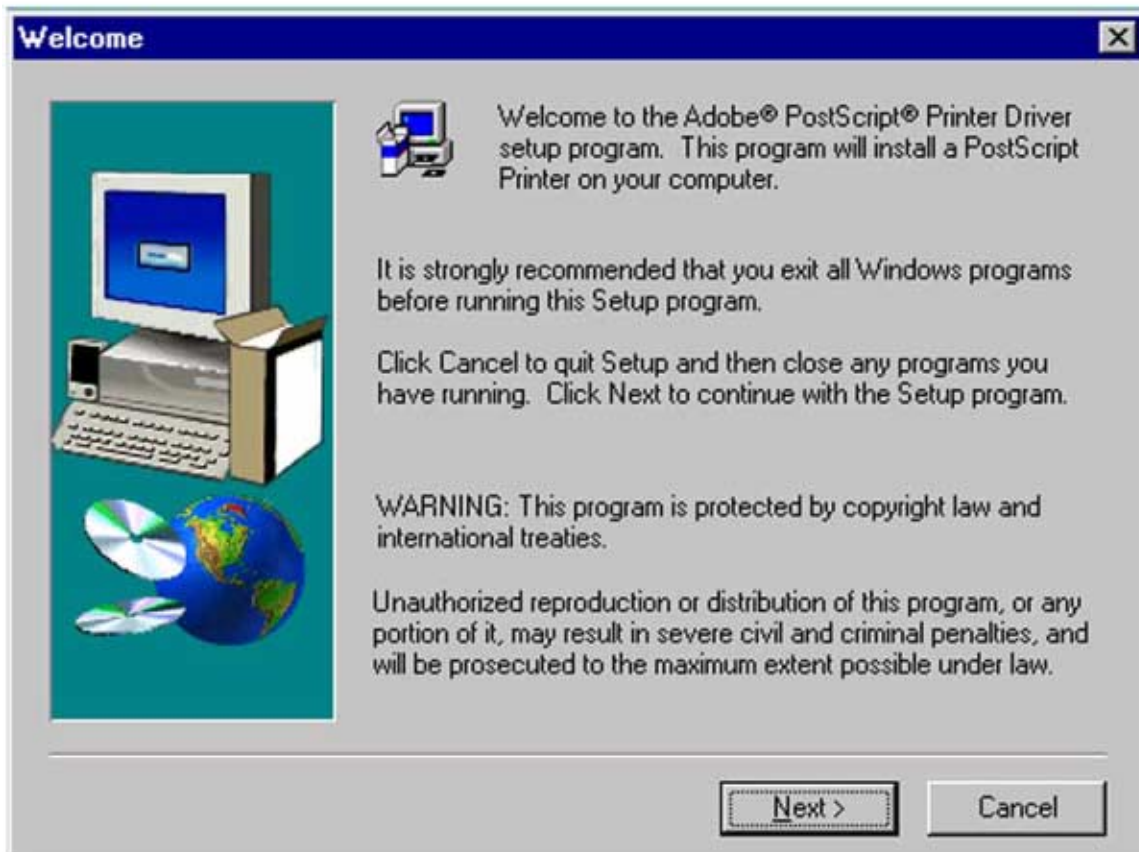

Current Release for both drivers is found in the Version 1.02 Universal Installer at:

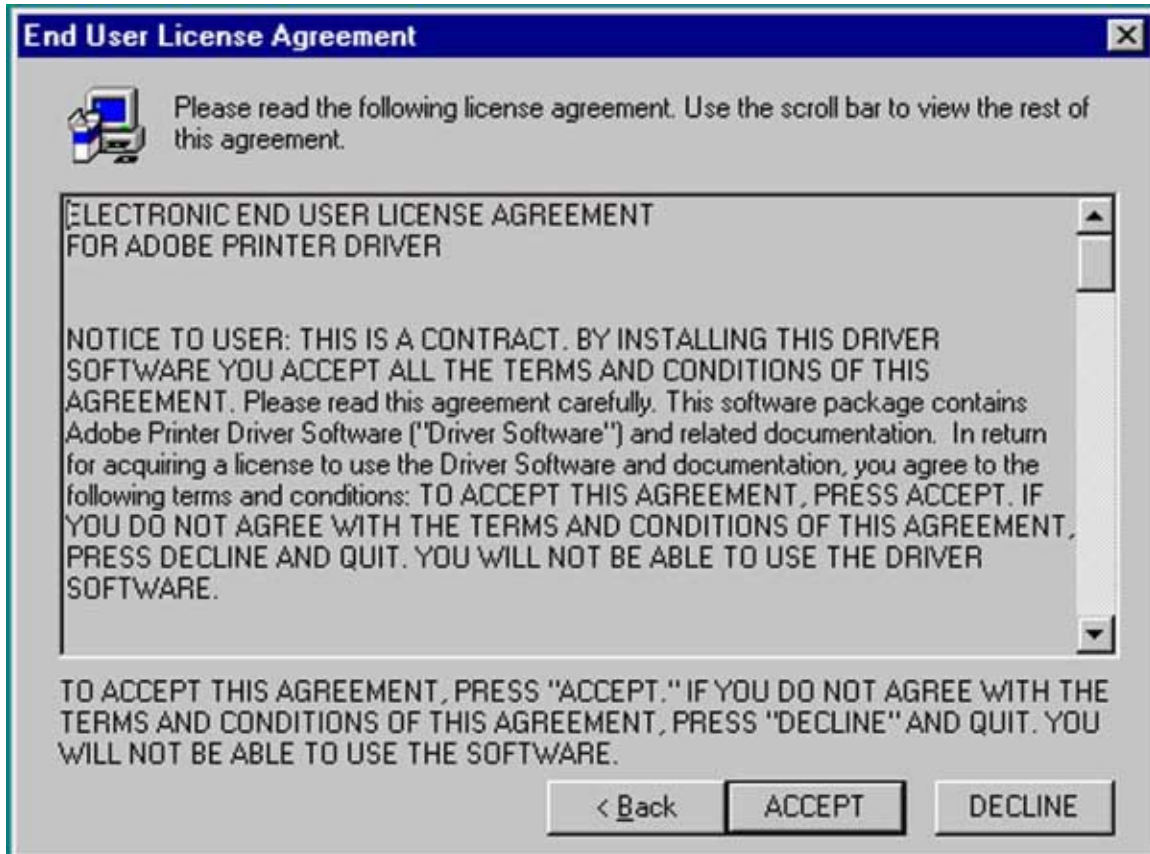

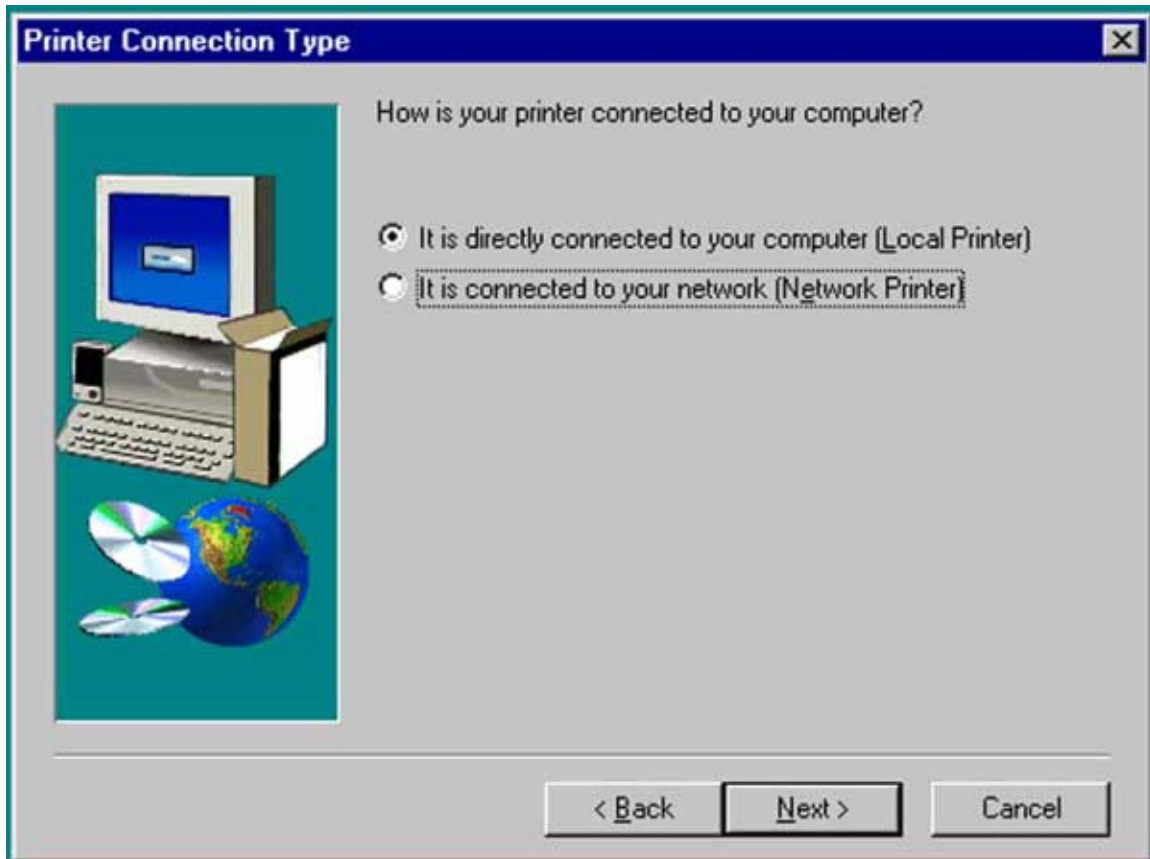
1. Log in as Administrator
2. Download the current driver from <http://www.adobe.com/support/downloads/pdrvwin.htm> and save it to your desktop.
3. Double click the downloaded file (current name is aps102eng.exe for the English version). The following windows should open.
4. Click Next.



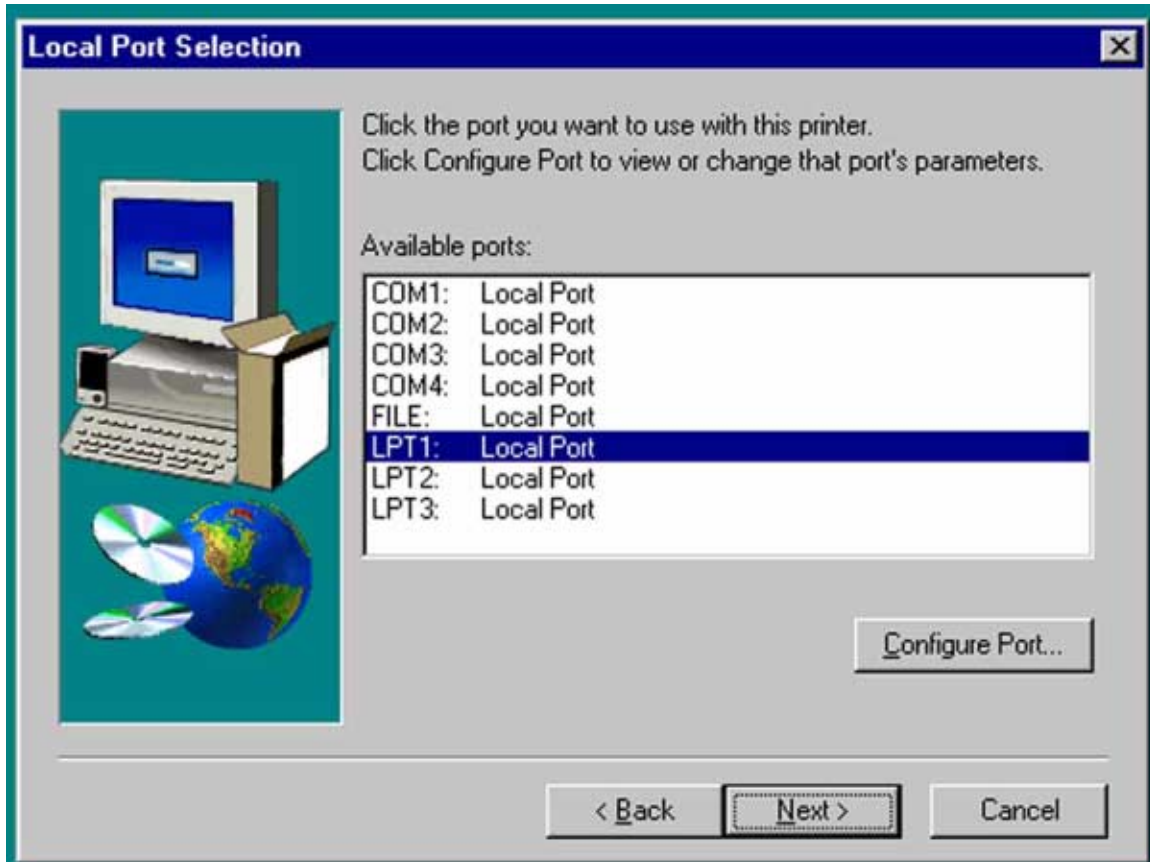
5. Click Accept.



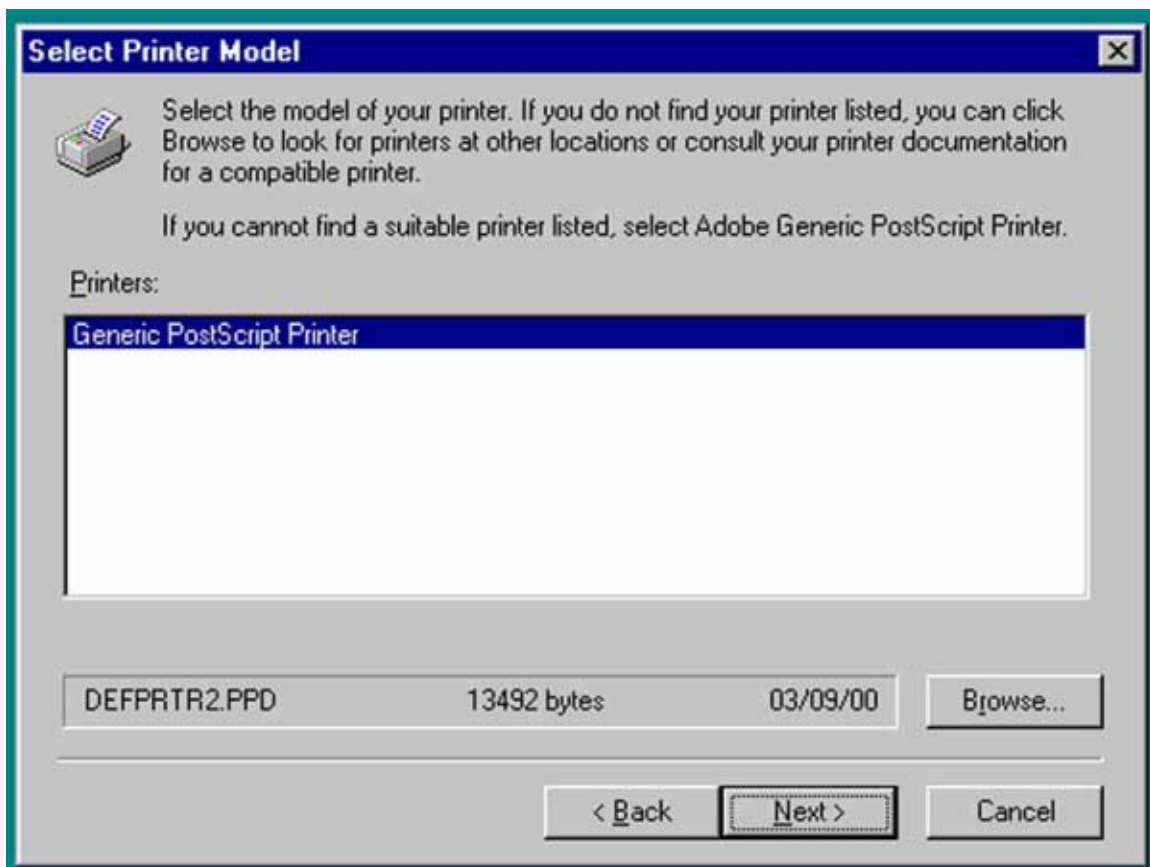
6. Select Local Printer (Directly connected to your machine) and click next.



7. Select LPT1, and click next.

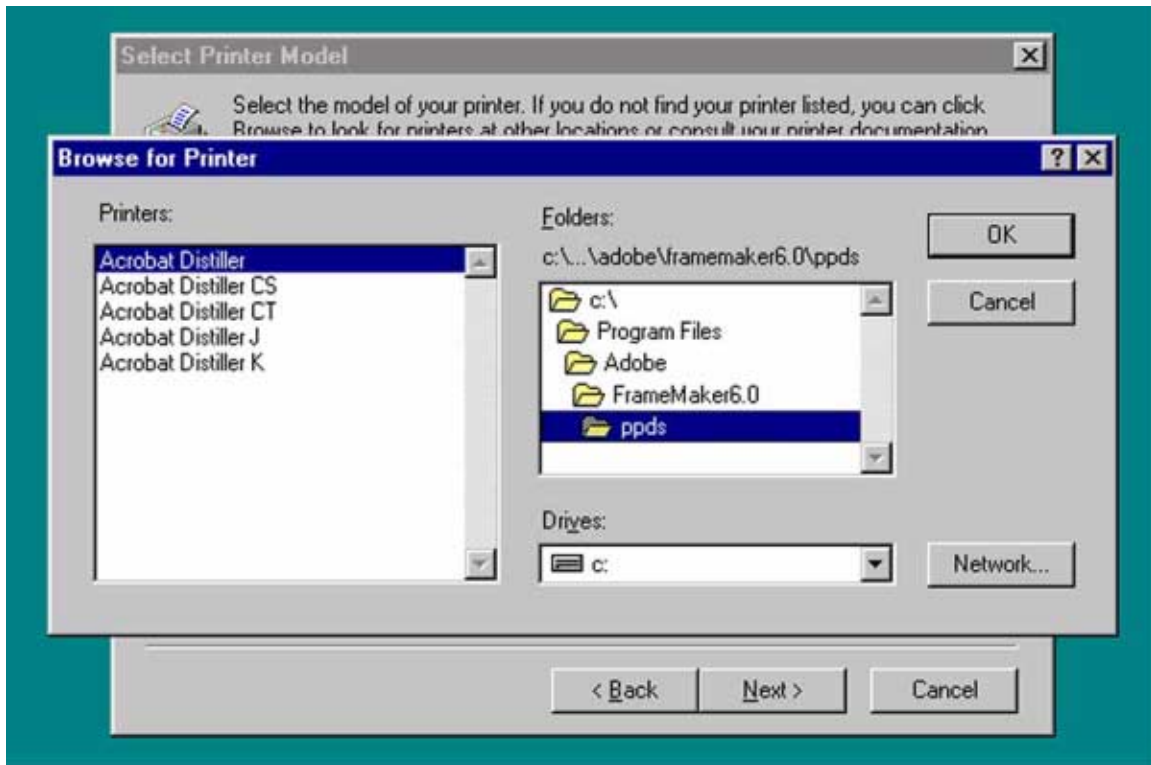


8. Click the Browse button.

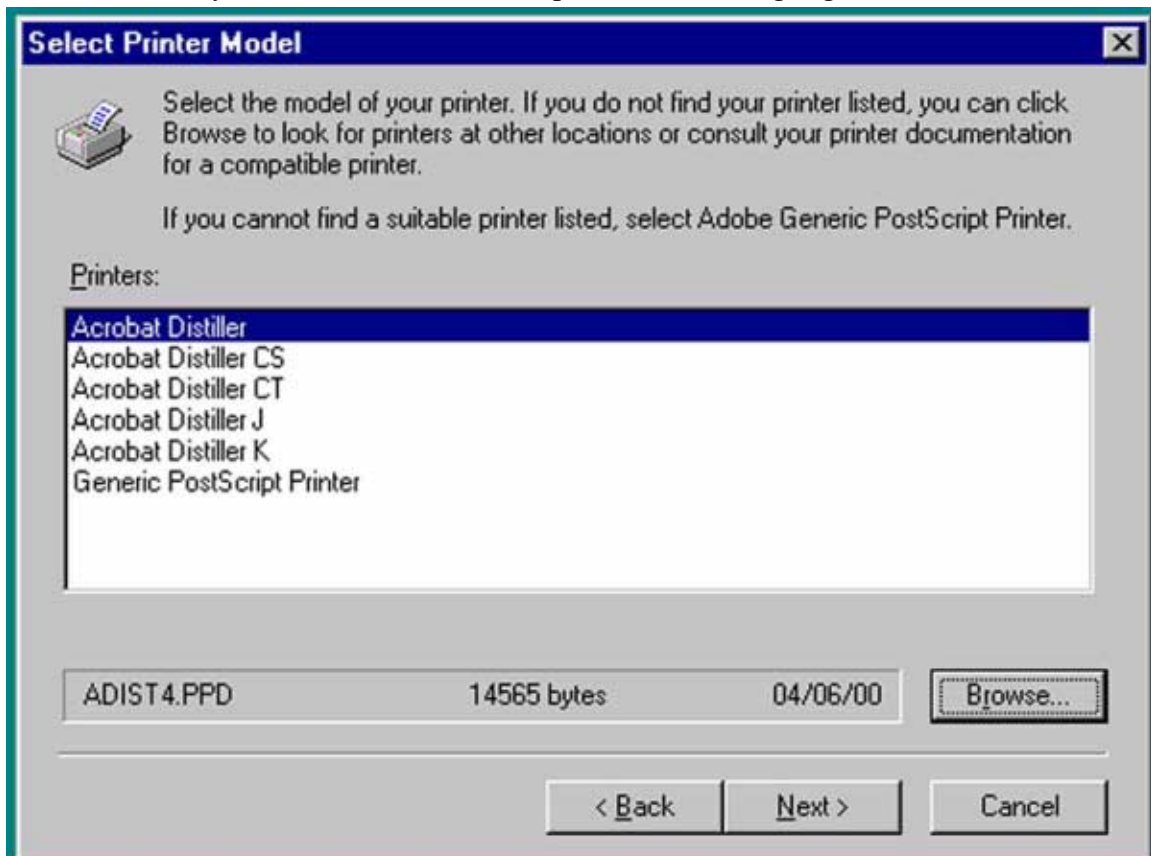


9. For Version 5.5x of FrameMaker, you will browse to the C:\Acrobat3\Distillr\Xtras folder. Then you will select the Acrobat Distiller 3.0 PPD in the left window and click OK.

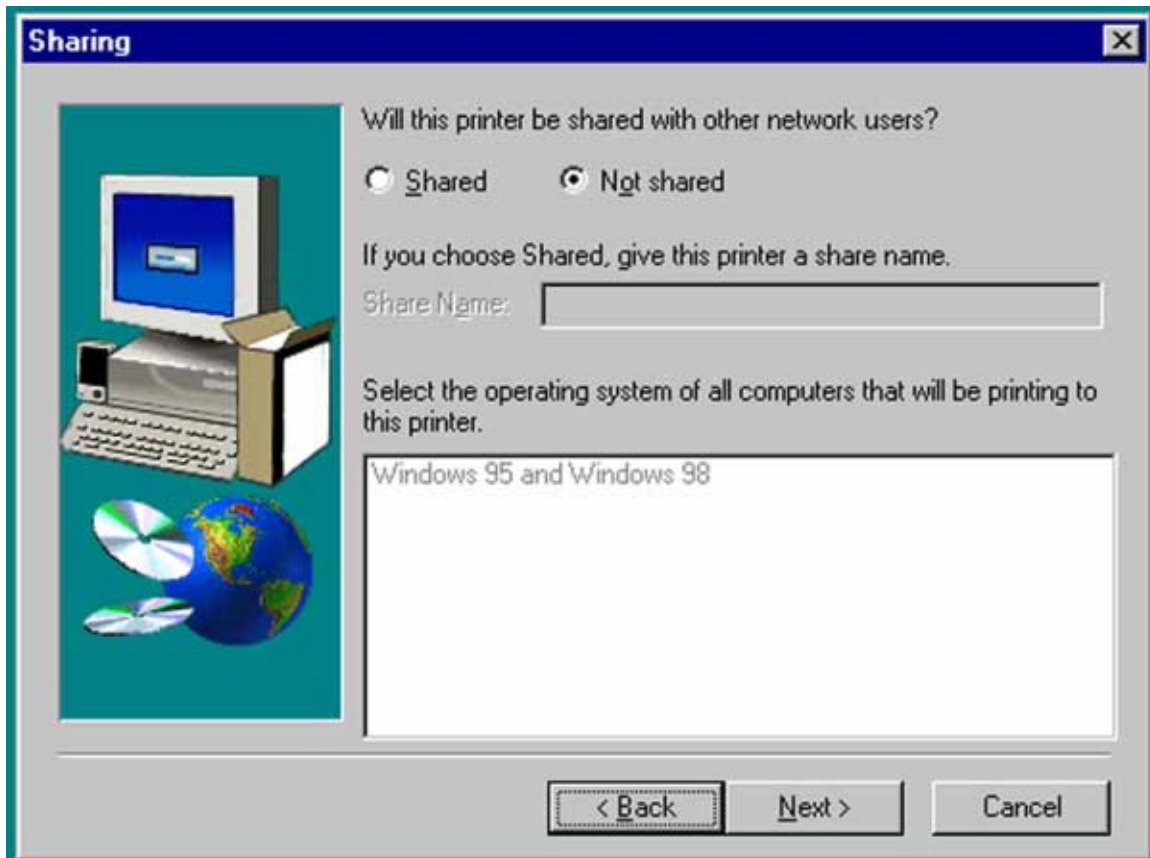
For Version 6.0 of Framemaker, you will browse to the C:\Program Files\Adobe\Framemaker 6.0\ppds folder and select the Acrobat Distiller PPD from the left window and click OK.



10. Make sure that your selection from the step above is still highlighted, and click Next.



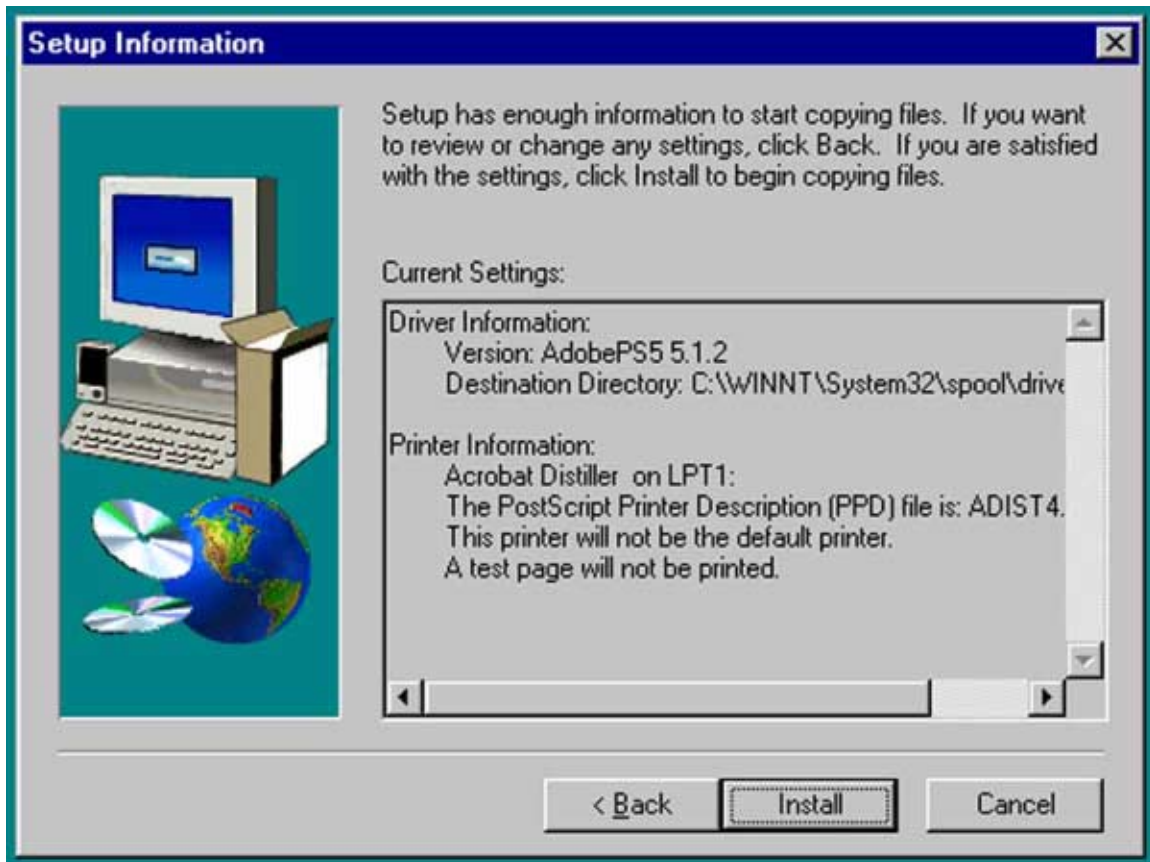
11. Select Not Shared, and click Next.



12. Name the Printer your desired name (most leave it as is).
Set Make this printer your default to Yes.
Set Print a test page to No.
Click Next.



13. Click Install.



14. Set Configure your printer now to No.
Click Next.



15. Select that you would like to read the readme file.
Click Finish.
Read the readme, close it, and the install is finished.
